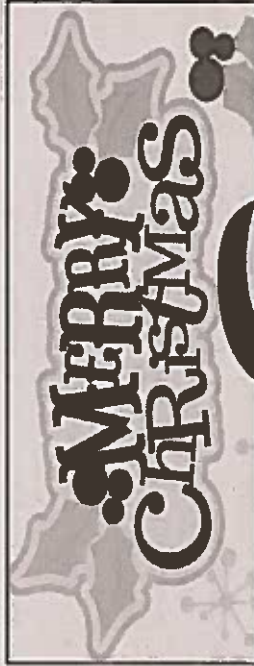

The weather allowed only three days on the lake last week as some much needed rain came our way!

I never complain about rain as we always seem to need some in Central and North Texas.

The strong wind associated with a couple of cool fronts kept us off the lake a day or two also.

However, the three days I did fish were VERY GOOD with lots of catfish on all three trips and some white bass on one trip.

The Thomas family, of Dallas, (pictured at left) joined me one morning for a combo trip where we caught around 50 catfish in the timber on the Richland Creek arm and then moved to the main lake area and caught another 25 magnum white bass and some small hybrid stripers.

We had action all morning long and the

group went home with plenty of filets for upcoming fish fries!

No real new news as this type of fishing will be good almost all fall and winter.

We're continuing to catch the blue and channel catfish on Danny Kings Punch Bait on a No. 4 Treble Hook in the heavy timber way up the Richland Creek arm of the lake.

The white bass are being caught on RSR silver slabs (www.rsrures.com) off main lake points in water around 20 feet deep.
